VenaSeal Closure™

Preparation

- In advance of the procedure, your physician will supply you with the details you need in order to prepare for this procedure.
- Please do not apply any creams or lotions to legs in advance of the procedure.
- You may eat a light meal and drink normally before your procedure.
- Sessions last about an hour, but may vary depending on number of veins being treated.

Brief Description of Test

Rather than using heat to close off an incompetent vein, VenaSeal Closure™ uses a medical adhesive, which in turn serves to reroute blood flow to healthier veins. In most cases, post-procedure compression hose are not needed and patients may exercise immediately after their procedure.
